Collage Activity

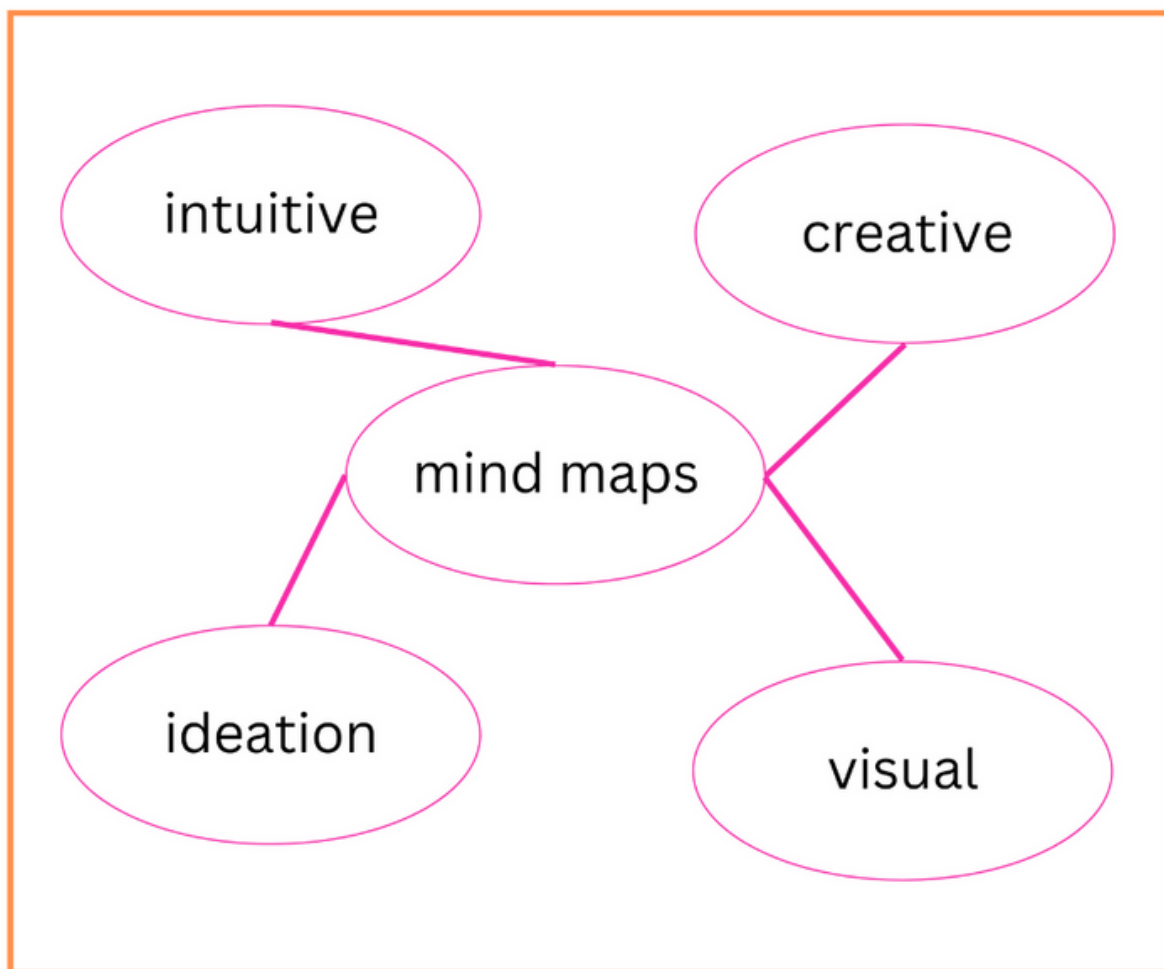

We have many collage activities in this book to encourage creative thinking. Refer to this page when asked to create a collage.



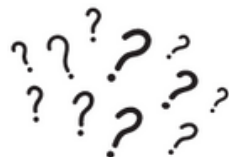
What is a Mind Map?

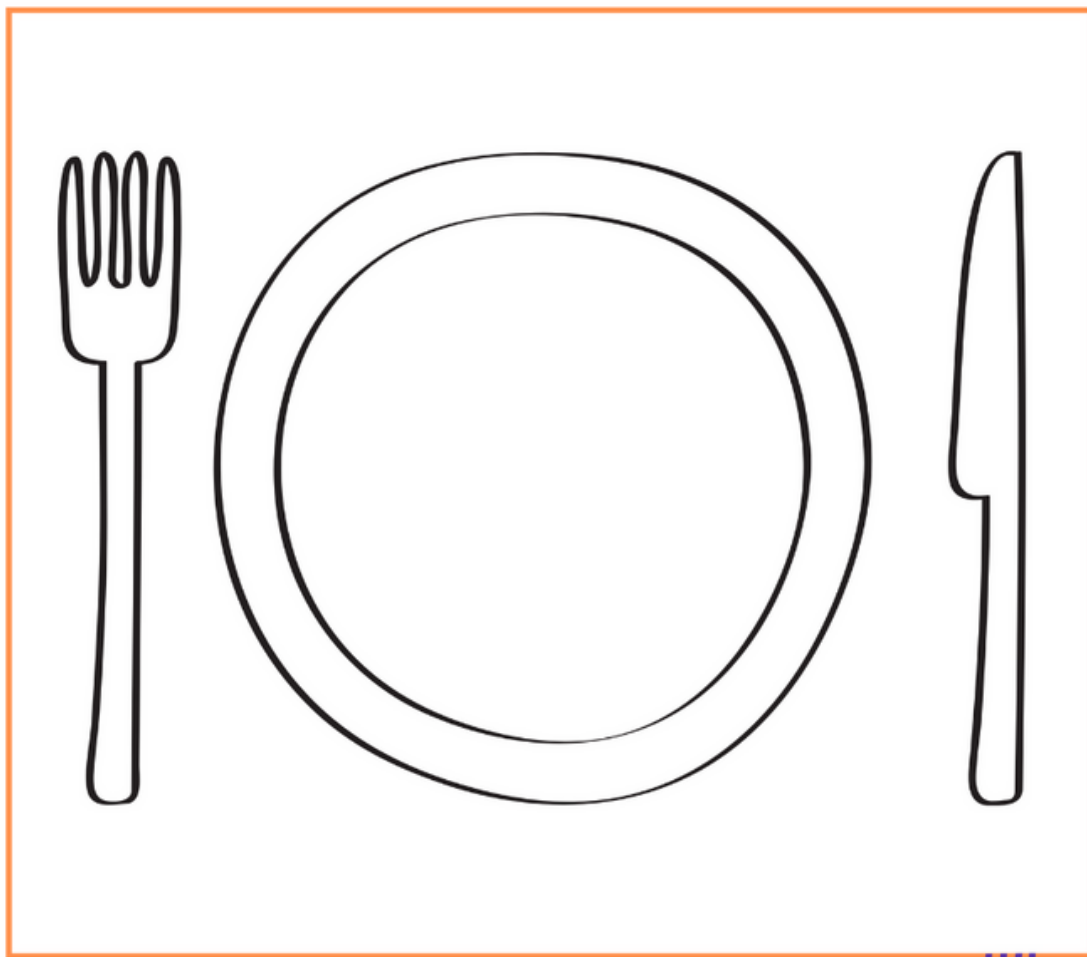
What Neighborhood Do You Spend Most of Your Time In?



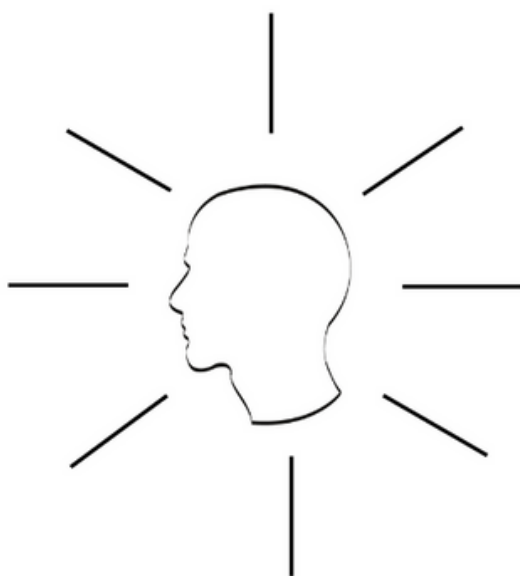

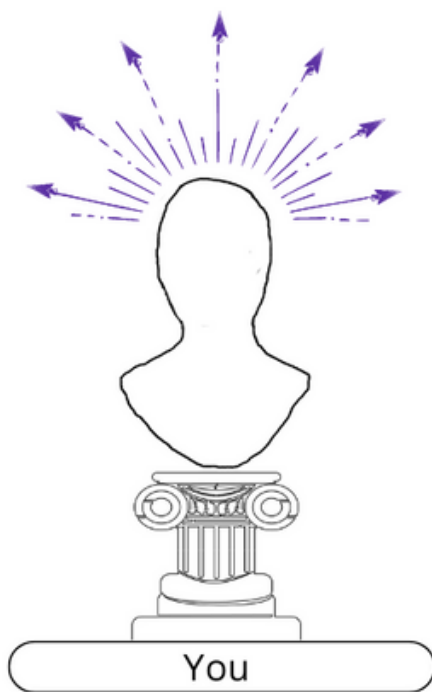
Look Back to Your List of Monuments: Do Any of These Represent an Individual?

If so, who may have supported this individual on their journey to greatness? What might their story be? Research or create a story of your own. Use a mind map to illustrate your thoughts and ideas.



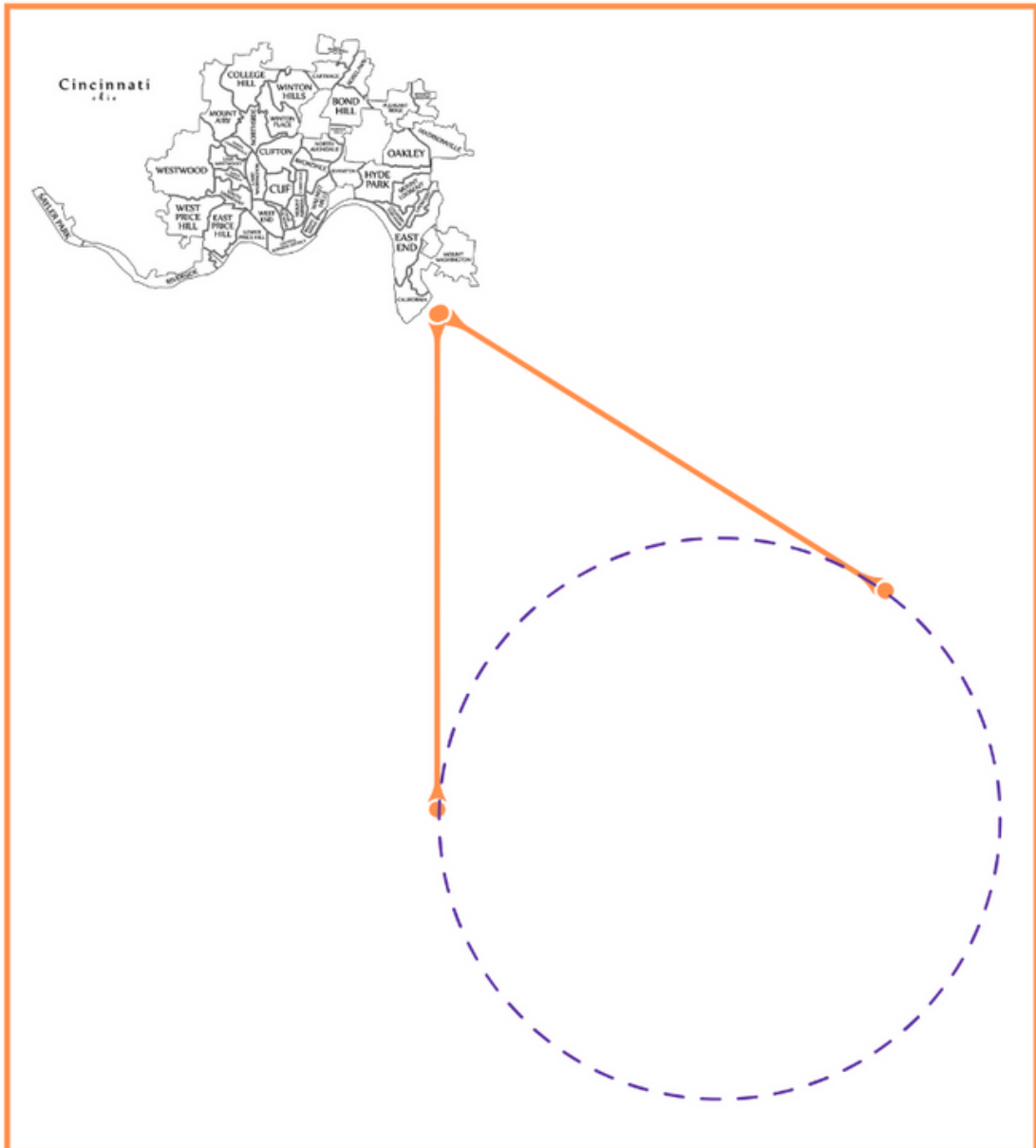
Do You Feel You are Personally Reflected in Cincinnati Monuments?

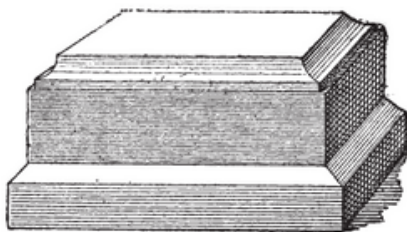
Where Would You Like to See a New Monument?
