

ARTWORK SAMPLES: (BRING THIS TO YOUR INTERVIEW)

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY

Please complete **two** of the following options and bring to your interview. One work sample must be a self-portrait, for the second sample you may choose between options 1 – 3. ArtWorks will keep your work so please be sure to capture a picture or print a picture for us to keep. All works must be submitted on an 8.5" x 11" sheet of paper and have your name legibly written on each work.

- Your art samples must be 8.5 x 11. Please don't fold the paper. Do not frame or mount the drawing.
- This drawing will NOT be returned to you after your interview; we will keep it as part of your application file.
- Include your name on each artwork sample submitted.

ARTWORK SAMPLE 1: SELF-PORTRAIT

To complete this drawing sample:

- Using a mirror (not a photo!), draw a detailed image of yourself.
- Use only a graphite pencil. Be sure to show light and dark areas and your unique personality.

ARTWORK SAMPLE 2: CHOOSE FROM THE FOLLOWING OPTIONS

OPTION 1: STILL LIFE

A still life is a detailed picture of non-moving objects.

To complete this drawing sample:

- Set up at least three objects to draw.
- Use any dry media such as graphite pencil or colored pencil to create a detailed drawing of the objects. Be sure to pay attention to the size and shape of the objects that you draw, the way you arrange them in your composition, as well as showing light and dark areas.

OPTION 2: INSIGNIA

An insignia is a collection of symbols, images and colors that create a unique design representing your identity or character.

To complete this drawing sample:

- Thinking about your personality characteristics, favorite things to do for fun, aspirations/goals and unique skills, draw your own person insignia.
- Use any dry media such as graphite pencil or colored pencil.
- Write a short statement that describes the significance of your insignia.

OPTION 3: OPEN MEDIA

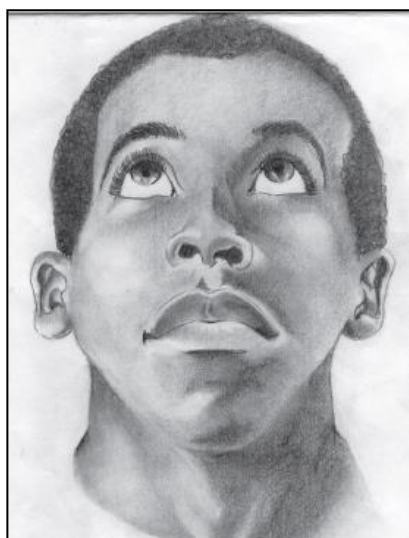
To complete this drawing sample:

- Share a work of your own creation in your preferred media such as paint, photography, textile, or mixed media.
- The final work must be 8.5" x 11" either create a new work at the appropriate size or submit a photograph of your work sized 8.5" x 11".
