Volunteer for ArtWorks Apprentice Interviews

Help conduct interviews with talented, local youth for our 2017 Apprentice Program!

Volunteers are needed for one-on-one scripted interviews with 300+ teen and student artists ages 14–21. Each interview lasts for about 30 minutes. After the interview, volunteers assess each applicant and provide feedback to help ArtWorks make hiring decisions.

ArtWorks will provide a script, guidelines and criteria to help you in the interview process and evaluation of each applicant. A 30-minute required volunteer orientation will be held at the start of each volunteer shift.

Qualifications

- Interviewers must be 25 years of age or older
- Interviewers must be professional, punctual and possess excellent communication skills
- Interviewers are required to attend a 30-min orientation at the start of their shift and at least one full shift
- Preferred familiarity with the ArtWorks program. *(No arts background required)*
